

## **Schmange - The Band Behind "PhaseIV Chronicles"**

**Schmange** hails from Cornwall, U.K. The band was formed in January 2000 to perform live material that was recorded and produced in the studio by guitarist Kevin Taylor. All members of the group are outstanding professional musicians with years of experience in numerous successful studio and live bands.

**Schmange** has just released "PhaseIV Chronicles". An album of 31 songs contained on a double CD. The album ranges from heavy rock songs like "MoogBoog" containing explosive lead solos, to electronic dance / techno tunes like "Rocksplosion". All tracks were originally played and produced by Kevin Taylor in his U.K studio, who then went on a quest to find a band of exceptional musicians who could perform his music live.

Kevin (Schmange) Taylor has recorded 2 albums. In addition to "PhaseIV Chronicles", he also wrote and produced "The Dark". An album containing several unique remixes, alternate takes and instrumental versions of several of the hit songs included on "PhaseIV Chronicles"

The band is currently in the studio working on their third CD release and will be returning to live touring in late 2006

**Schmange** has an extensive history of touring and playing live. They have performed numerous concerts in the Baltic States, Scandinavia, Poland, Hungary, Germany, Italy, France, Spain and Switzerland. With the release of "**PhaseIV Chronicles**", Schmange is also planning to expand their audiences in Europe, Japan, the U.S. and Canada.

**Schmange** will spend most of the summer of 2006 working on new material and hope to get back on the road by August or September of 2006. Judging from the feedback that Schmange have received so far, their unique blend of techno/rock has generated a lot of positive interest among both techno dance fans and hard rock enthusiasts.
